According to diocesan policy, the parish must be contacted six months prior to the intended wedding date. Please call the Parish Center (ext. 201) for information.

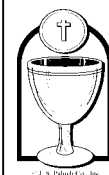
**If you are hospitalized...**

### ADVENT EXPECTING:

The General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar simply describe Advent as “a period for devout and joyful expectation” (no. 39). Naturally, with this Fourth Sunday of Advent our expectation is heightened.



Christmas is almost here! Yet we can so easily fool ourselves; once Christmas Day arrives we might think our expectation is ended. Actually, it’s only begun!

Christian living is characterized by expectation: Christ continually comes in the most unexpected ways. Jesus’ birth so long ago unleashed a new and startling presence of God in our midst. Since that time our expectation never ceases; we live for Christ’s comings. The surprise of the Good News of salvation is that God comes to dwell among us, to be at home with us. Our wildest dreams, our most heartfelt expectations are fulfilled in the birth of this Savior, Emmanuel, “God with us.”

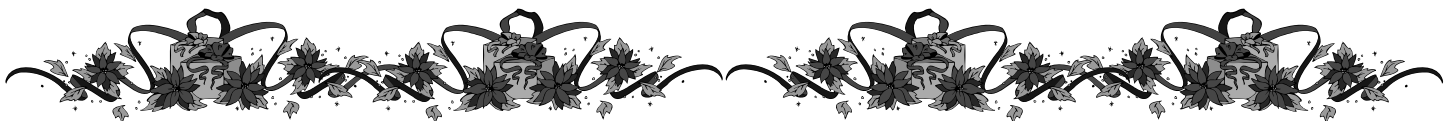
