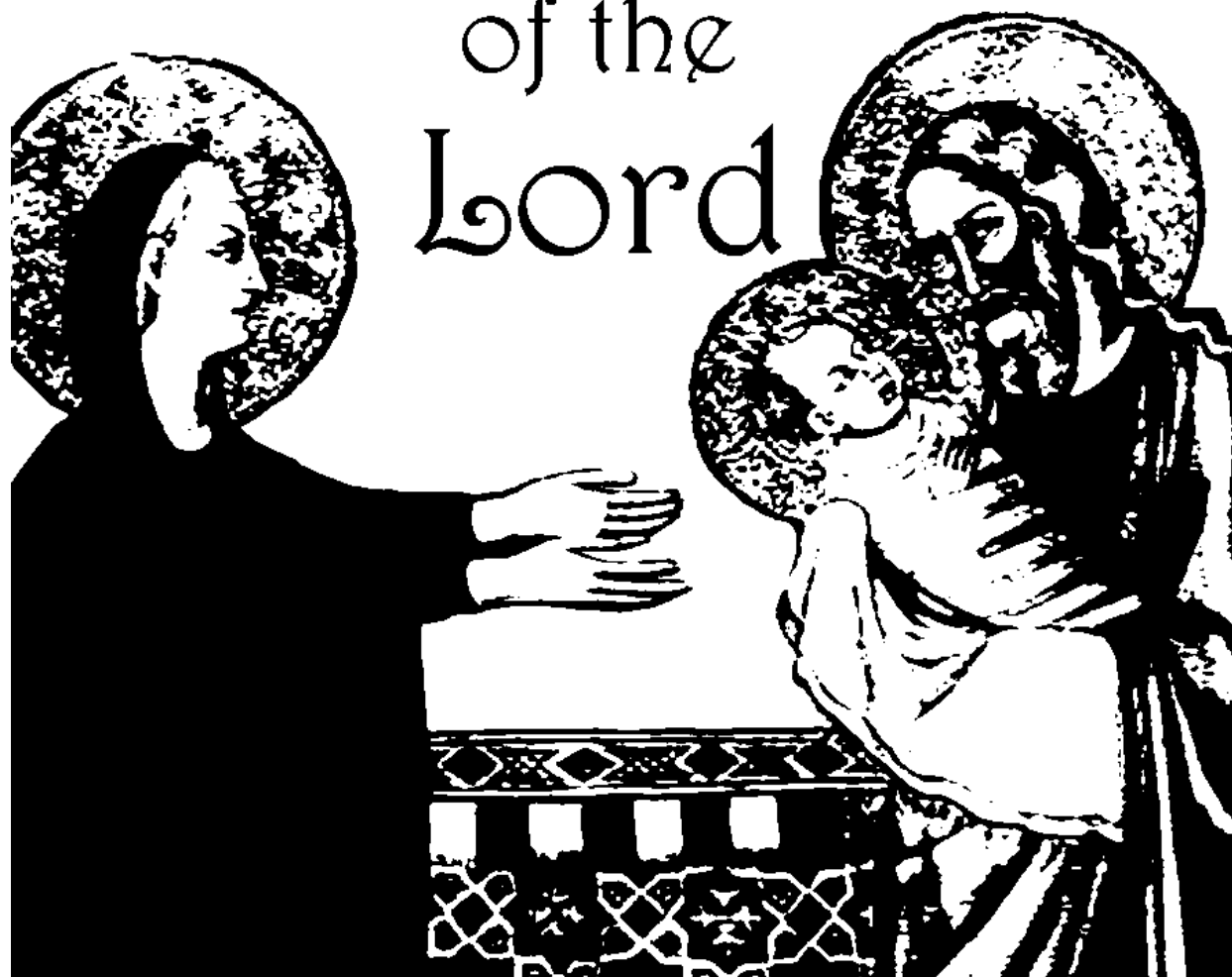

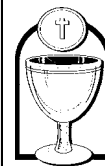
### If you are hospitalized...

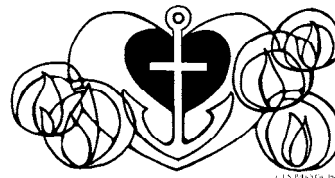

### Senior Citizen Real Estate Tax Deferral Forms Due By March 1, 2010

The Senior Citizens Real Estate Tax Deferral Program provides tax relief for qualified senior citizens by allowing them to defer their property tax on their principal residence.

The deferral is similar to a loan against the property's market value. Deferred amounts are borrowed from the State of Illinois, who then pays the tax bill. To ensure repayment, a six percent simple interest rate is charged on the deferred amounts and a lien is filed on the property.

Deferred amounts must be repaid within one year of the settlement of the estate or at the time the property is sold or title is transferred.
