+ THE EASTER VIGIL IN THE HOLY NIGHT +

April 16 | 8:00pm

On this night's Vigil, which is the greatest and most noble of all solemnities, there is to be only one celebration in Church – it is the Paschal Mass of the Sunday of the Resurrection.

April 17 | 8:30am • 10:00am • 11:30am

+ WEEKDAY MASSES WITHIN THE OCTAVE OF EASTER +

Easter, our most important liturgical observance, is celebrated for fifty days, longer than any other feast in the calendar.

The Great Fifty Days, as it is sometimes called, is observed as a single feast from Easter Sunday (April 17) to Pentecost Sunday (June 5).
