BLESSED VIRGIN MARY GROTTO RENOVATION PROJECT

GROTTO UPDATE:

The Grotto renovation project broke ground on April 6. Like every good project and church community, it began with a strong foundation of concrete and steel. Footing work has also been completed for the esteemed pillars at the entrance to the shrine which will be used to recognize our generous donors.

If you wish to donate, please use one of the two QR codes below, drop a check at the main office, or watch for special designated envelopes in your next packet.

The Blessed Virgin Mary Grotto on the north side of the school building holds a special place for our parish community – celebrating May Crowning, capturing photos of special occasions such as First Communion or Confirmation, praying weekly Tuesday Evening Rosary outdoors in warm months, and of course it is a place of respite for personal prayer.

The statue was acquired from Italy and was originally donated by Mr./Mrs. Robert and Gerry Barth, and Mr./Mrs. Phil Starbuck, in memory of their children, Brian Barth (age 5), and Mary Gwen Starbuck (age 6), both of whom died tragically at an early age.

Throughout the years, parishioners have made time to meditate in the grotto, praying for Mary's guidance and intercession. Unfortunately, over time, the statue has undergone damage, leaving Mary's thumbs broken, and the grotto itself needs refreshing.

After prayerful consideration, and months of planning, renovations are now underway.

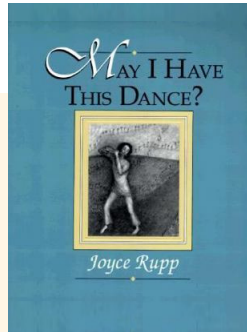
FIRST FRIDAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION MAY 1

Good Friday in Downers Grove

Thank you to everyone who participated in the Ecumenical Way of the Cross for the Victims of Abortion that was held this year on Good Friday in front of the Access Health Center (Abortion Clinic) in Downers Grove. The event was sponsored by various Knights of Columbus Councils, including St. Peter the Apostle Parish Council #10884, Mayslake Council #4053 in Darien, Robert P Connelly Council #5918 in Woodridge and the St. Joan of Arc Council #15168 in Lisle. A group of approximately 50 people, including 15 of our parishioners, gathered to pray for all innocent victims who suffered the cruelty of abortion. Father Gregor Gorsic from St. Matthew Parish in Glendale Heights led the Way of the Cross, recounting the Holy Passion of our Lord while praying for all victims of abortion. The service concluded with those present praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet for all the victims of abortion.
