a yearning for the treasures of heaven.

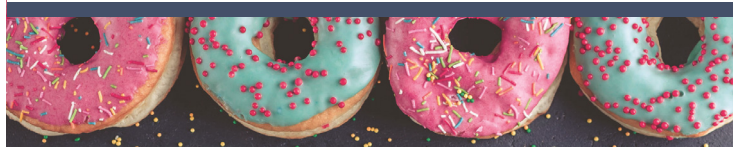

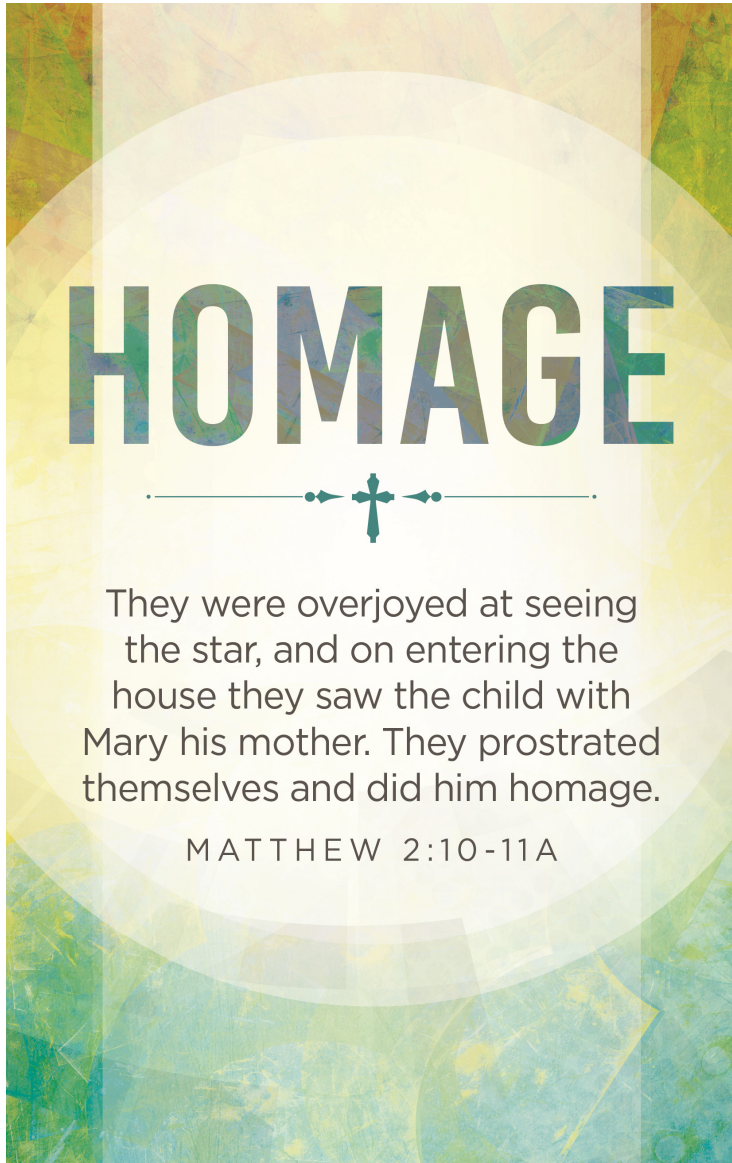

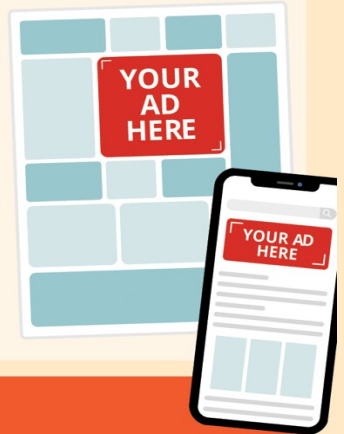
