Opening Song (optional)

Leader: *Let us begin...*

The Apostles' Creed

Leader: *I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.*

All: *I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.*

The Our Father

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

The Hail Mary (repeat three times) (for the virtues of Faith, Hope and Charity)

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES *(typically prayed on Monday & Saturday)*

THE FIRST JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Annunciation of the Lord to Mary

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of humility.*

THE SECOND JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of love of thy neighbor.*

THE THIRD JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of poverty of spirit.*

THE FOURTH JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Presentation of Our Lord

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of purity of mind, body, heart and will.*

THE FIFTH JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Finding of Jesus in The Temple

Meditation: *Lord, grant me wisdom and the grace of obedience.*

Recite the following prayers for each mystery:

> Our Father...

> Hail Mary... *(repeat ten times)*

> Glory Be...

> The Fatima Prayer: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Your Mercy.*

THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES *(typically prayed on Thursday)*

THE FIRST LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan

Meditation: *Lord, grant me gratitude for the gift of faith.*

THE SECOND LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Wedding at Cana

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of fidelity.*

THE THIRD LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Proclamation of The Kingdom of God

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the desire for holiness.*

THE FOURTH LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Transfiguration

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of spiritual courage*

THE FIFTH LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Institution of The Eucharist

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of love of our Eucharistic Lord.*

Recite the following prayers for each mystery:

> Hail Mary *(repeat ten times)*

> Glory Be

> The Fatima Prayer: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Your Mercy.*

THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES (typically prayed on Tuesday & Friday)

THE FIRST SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Agony of Jesus in the Garden

Meditation: *Lord, grant me contrition for my sins and the grace to forgive others.*

THE SECOND SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Scourging at the Pillar

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace to mortify my senses.*

THE THIRD SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Crowning With Thorns

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace to be in the world, but not of it.*

THE FOURTH SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Carrying of the Cross

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of patience in times of tribulation.*

THE FIFTH SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Crucifixion of Our Lord

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of pardoning of injuries.*

Recite the following prayers for each mystery:

THE SECOND GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Ascension of Jesus to Heaven

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of hope.*

THE THIRD GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Descent of The Holy Spirit

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of all gifts from the Holy Spirit.*

THE FOURTH GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Assumption of Mary into Heaven

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace to love you as our lady desires.*

THE FIFTH GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Coronation of Mary

Meditation: *Lord, grant me the grace of final perseverance.*

Recite the following prayers for each mystery:
