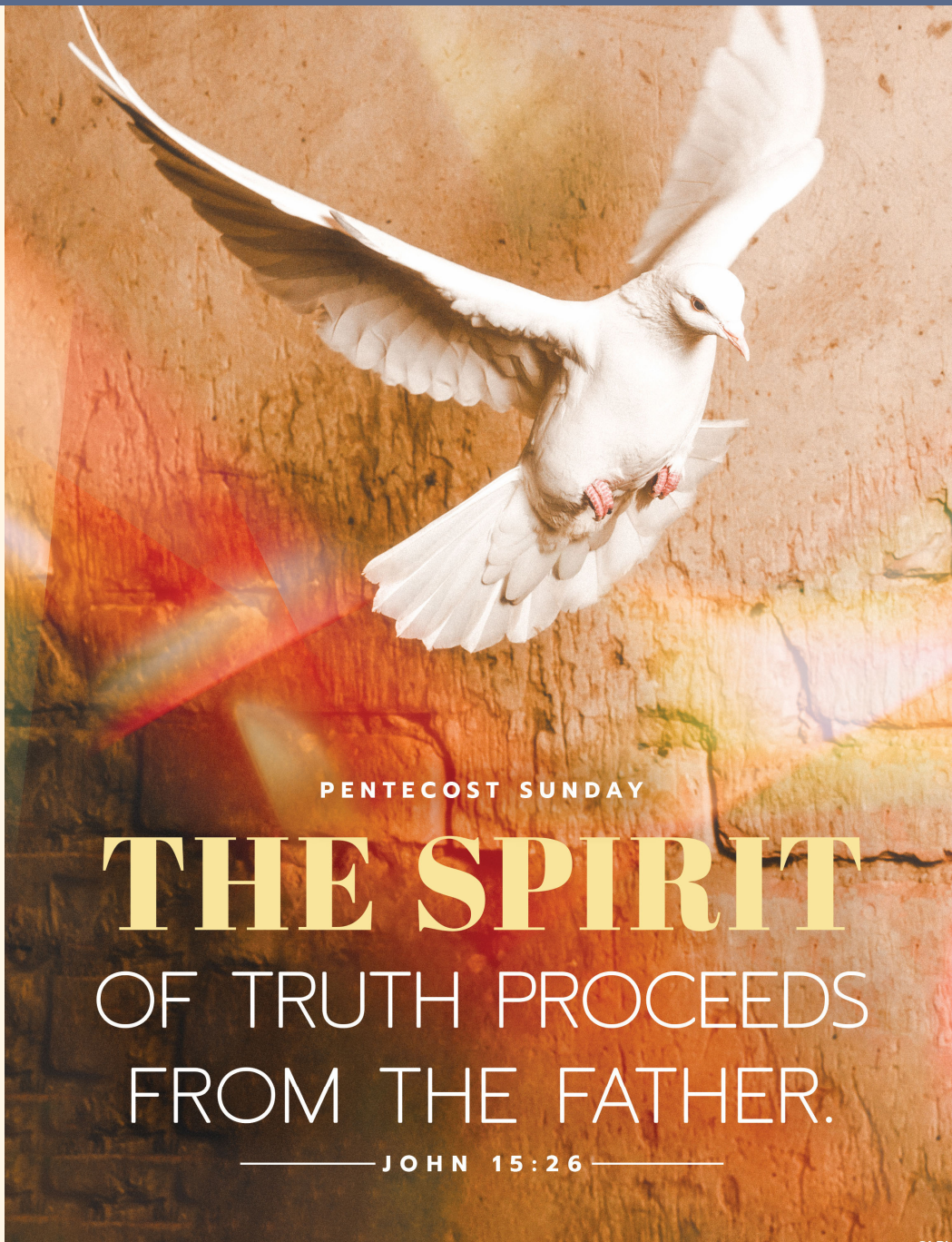

BLESSING OF MOTORCYCLES

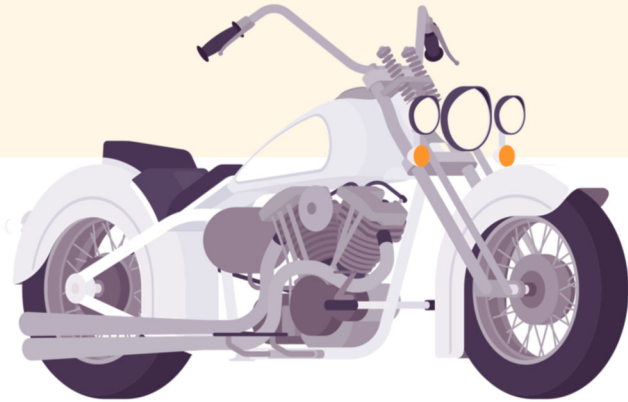
