Linda leads the hand bell ensemble at Sunday's 8:30 mass. This group practices weekly and plays monthly. Each Sunday mass enjoys the bells twice a year.

Brooklyn, our newest and youngest cantor, leads us in song at the 10:00 am Children's Mass. This weekend is just the second time Brooklyn has led the singing! Outside of music, she is also dedicated to Irish dance. We love Brooklyn's positive attitude as much as we do her beautiful voice!

Unfortunately, due to lack of interest, the St. Cecilia Children's Choir is struggling to get off the ground. But Sophia, whom you will hear sing the Gospel Acclamation at the Children's Mass, is a joyful assistant, helping younger children to read and setting a great example with her attention and voice. Sophia is also an altar server.

The Adult Choir usually sings at 10:00 am, but this weekend they are singing at the 11:30 am mass. The choir is where the music ministry needs the most help. For a functional choir, we need at least 20 more singers. Choir rehearses on Wednesdays at 7:15 pm.

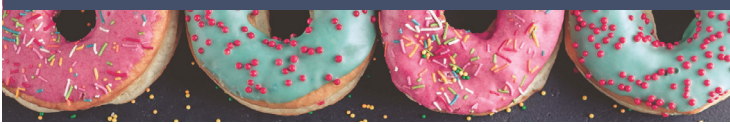

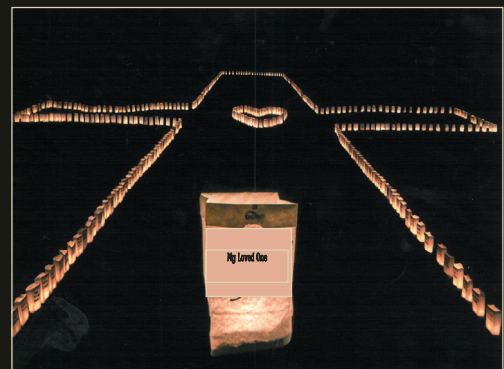

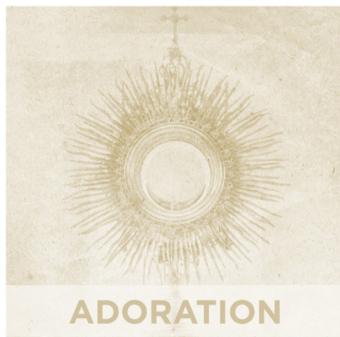

As a designated pilgrimage church, everyone who makes a pilgrimage to our church during the Jubilee Year 2025, and fulfills the conditions for a plenary indulgence can receive an indulgence for oneself or for someone who died.

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

A significant feature of the Jubilee year is the granting of a plenary indulgence – which is the complete removal of the effects of sin that remain in us even after we're forgiven.

These conditions need to be met for a plenary indulgence:

- Have complete detachment from sin in your life
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope
- Make a Sacramental Confession and be in the state of grace
- Receive Holy Communion

After these four conditions are met, a plenary indulgence can be obtained by visiting a pilgrimage site.
