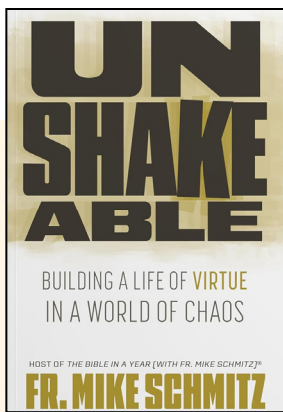
What is a Plenary Indulgence?

A significant feature of the Jubilee year is the granting of a
plenary indulgence – which is the complete removal of the
effects of sin that remain in us even after we're forgiven.

These conditions need to be met for a plenary indulgence:

- Have complete detachment from sin in your life
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope
- Make a Sacramental Confession and be in the state of grace
- Receive Holy Communion

After these four conditions are met, a plenary indulgence
can be obtained by visiting a pilgrimage site.

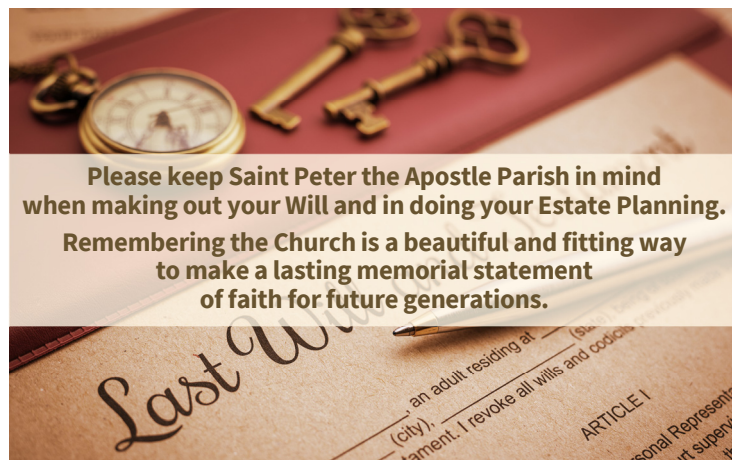

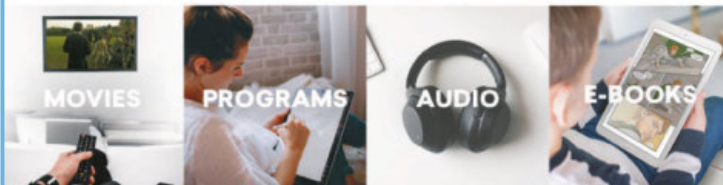

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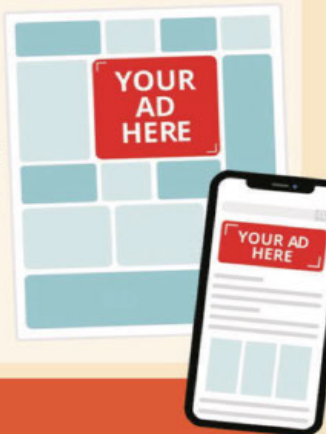
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
