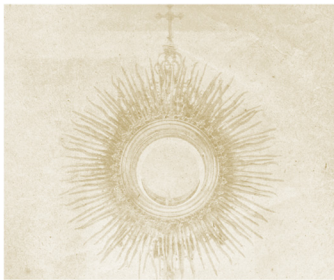

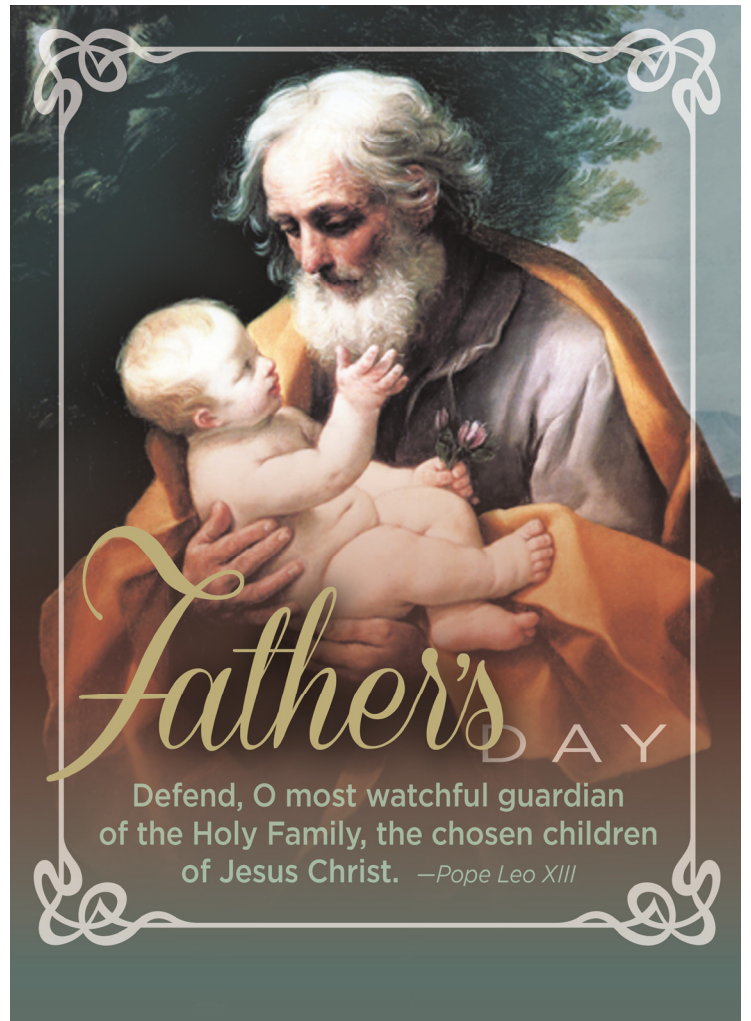
FATHER'S DAY – SECOND COLLECTION FOR RETIRED PRIESTS
