PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear parishioners:

On this special day, I want to wish all of our fathers a Happy Father's Day. Our fathers are very special people in our lives, and as sons and daughters, it is important to make the time to appreciate them.

It is also important for fathers to remember that they have been given a very special gift which should be treasured and nourished. I want to share with fathers a reflection about John Drescher's book, *If I Were Starting My Family Again* —

Drescher writes, "One thing I would do differently is to be more patient with my children when they interrupt my reading." Drescher illustrates his point by telling the story of a small boy who tried repeatedly to get his dad's attention. The little boy wanted to show his father a scratch on his finger. Finally, his dad put down his paper and said, "Well, what do you expect me to do about it?" The little boy looked at his dad and said, "You could at least say, 'Oh!'"

Father's Day is not just a day for us to appreciate Dad. It is also a day for Dad to appreciate what an important role he plays in the lives of those entrusted to his care.

And one of the most important ways Dad carries out this role is not by great, heroic sacrifices, but by countless little caring acts — like putting down a newspaper and saying "Oh!" to a little boy with a scratch on his finger.

This coming week, our parish is hosting **Vacation Bible School**. I am excited to welcome the children and celebrate Mass with them throughout the week. Last minute registrations are being taken, so if you haven't yet, I encourage you to do so. Next Sunday following 11:30am Mass, we will celebrate **Corpus Christi** with our traditional procession around the parish grounds. Finally, the following Sunday is our **Parish Picnic** — I'm looking forward to enjoying the afternoon with everyone.

Lord, I need your special care.

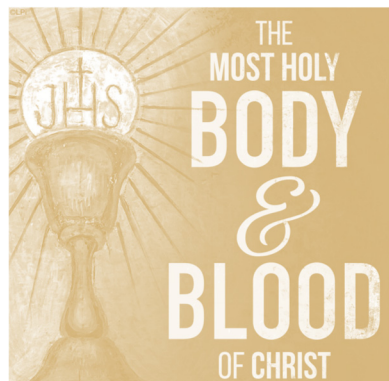
Like your earthly father, Joseph, I want to do God's will, even if I may not always understand.

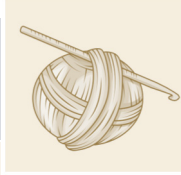

PORTA SANCTA

The Holy Door is the most powerful sign of the Jubilee. To pass through it expresses the decision to follow and be guided by Jesus, who is the Good Shepherd. As it states in St. John's gospel (10:9): "I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture."

Each of the panels of the Porta Sancta (Holy Door) portrays a scene of man's sin and his redemption through God's mercy —

Panel Number Seven

The seventh panel of the Holy Door (Porta Sancta) is a depiction of the famous scene from the parable of the Prodigal Son, when the son returns to beg his father's forgiveness, and his father embraces him. The panel is titled: "PATER PECCAUI · IN COELVM ET · CORAM TE," which translated means: Father I have sinned against Heaven and also you." This panel is the only panel on the Holy Door that depicts a parable, and so represents not only the Prodigal Son, but all of the parables that Jesus shared as He spread His message.

Panel Number Eight

The eighth panel of the Holy Door (Porta Sancta) shows Jesus healing the paralytic. It is titled "TOLLE · GRABATUM · TUUM · ET · AMBULA," which translated means "Take up your mat and walk." This panel is the only panel showing Jesus performing a miracle and so is representative of the many miracles He accomplished during His Earthly mission. It is an appropriate end to the second row of panels, all of which are focusing on Jesus's three-year active ministry for the salvation of mankind.

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

A significant feature of the Jubilee year is the granting of a plenary indulgence – which is the complete removal of the effects of sin that remain in us even after we're forgiven.

These conditions need to be met for a plenary indulgence:

- Have complete detachment from sin in your life
- Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis
- Make a Sacramental Confession and be in the state of grace
- Receive Holy Communion

After these four conditions are met, a plenary indulgence can be obtained by visiting a pilgrimage site.

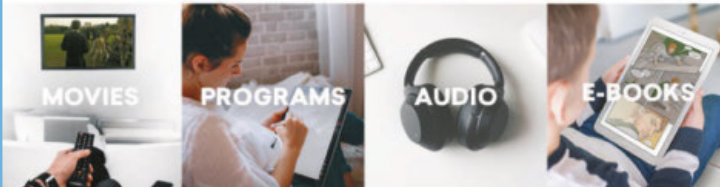

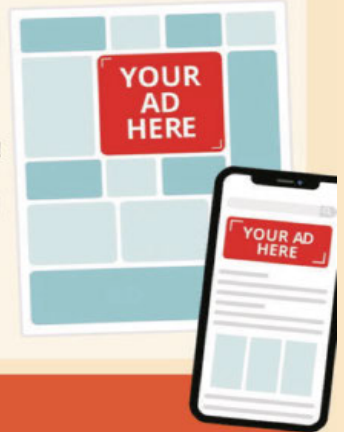
