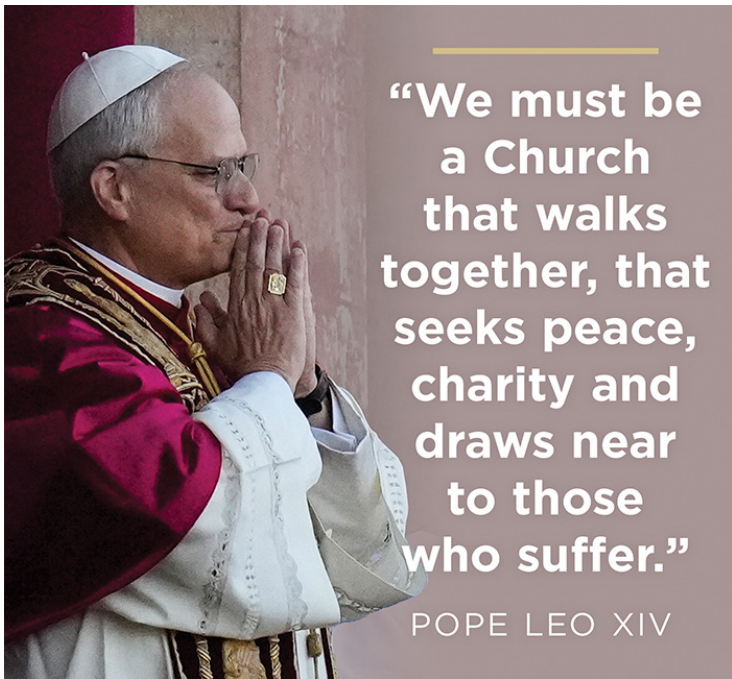

FR. TUAN, PASTOR

St. Faustina Kowalska and the Image of Divine Mercy: St. Faustina of Poland is the well-known apostle of Divine Mercy. On April 30, 2000, at 10:00 am on the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday, the Feast requested by Jesus in His communications with St. Faustina), His Holiness Pope St. John Paul II celebrated the Eucharist in Saint Peter's Square and proceeded to the canonization of Blessed Sister Faustina Kowalska. [John Paul himself would be canonized on this same Feast Day – April 27 in 2014 – by Pope Francis.] St. Faustina invites us by the witness of her life to keep our faith and hope fixed on God the Father, rich in mercy, Who saved us by the precious Blood of His Son, Jesus. The Lord Jesus assigned to St. Faustina during her short life three basic tasks: 1. to pray for souls, entrusting them to God's incomprehensible Mercy; 2. to tell the world about God's generous Mercy; 3. to start a new movement in the Church focusing on God's Mercy. "The Lord of Divine Mercy," a drawing of Jesus based on the vision given to St. Faustina Kowalska, shows Jesus raising his right hand in a gesture of blessing, with His left hand on his heart from which gush forth two rays, one red and one white. The picture contains the message, "Jesus, I trust in You!" (Jezu ufam Tobie). The rays streaming out have symbolic meanings: the red for the Blood of Jesus, which is the life of our souls; and the white for the water of Baptism which justifies souls. The whole image is symbolic of the mercy, forgiveness and love of God.

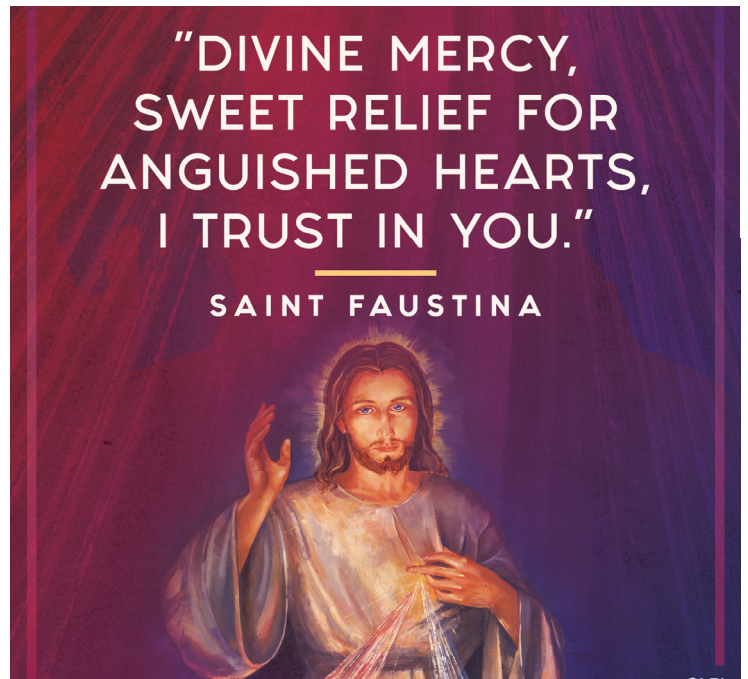

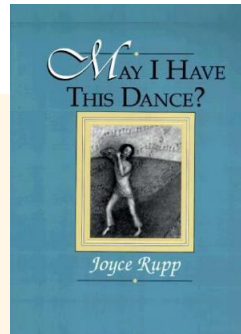

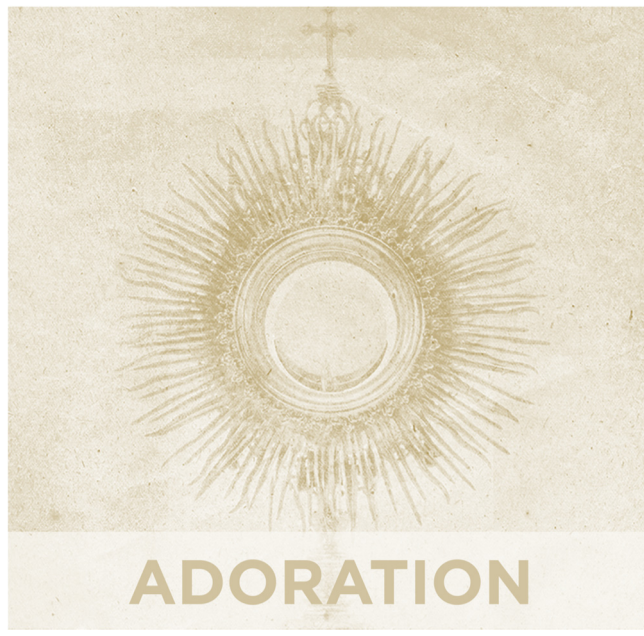

BLESSED VIRGIN MARY GROTTO RENOVATION PROJECT

A Groundbreaking Ceremony took place on Monday, April 6, commemorating the official start of construction for the Blessed Virgin Mary Grotto renovation project.



The Blessed Virgin Mary Grotto on the north side of the school building holds a special place for our parish community – celebrating May Crowning, capturing photos of special occasions such as First Communion or Confirmation, praying weekly Tuesday Evening Rosary outdoors in warm months, and of course it is a place of respite for personal prayer.

The statue was acquired from Italy and was originally donated by Mr./Mrs. Robert and Gerry Barth, and Mr./Mrs. Phil Starbuck, in memory of their children, Brian Barth (age 5), and Mary Gwen Starbuck (age 6), both of whom died tragically at an early age.

Throughout the years, parishioners have made time to meditate in the grotto, praying for Mary's guidance and intercession. Unfortunately, over time, the statue has undergone damage, leaving Mary's thumbs broken, and the grotto itself needs refreshing.

After prayerful consideration, and months of planning, renovations are now underway.
