PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners:

I am very excited to be celebrating **First Holy Communion** with our children this weekend. As always, I am filled with joy to share Jesus with our children in the Eucharist for the first time. I remind the children how much Jesus loves them and comes to them in the Eucharist as a sign of His love for them. This is a special event for the children, as well as their parents. I often see tears of joy in parents' eyes as they watch their children receive Jesus for the first time.

Thank you to Toni Pietrowski, Kathy Frank, and all of the wonderful Catechists for preparing the children for this special day, as well as to their parents as primary teachers and examples of faith.

Next weekend we will celebrate Mother's Day, as well as the May Crowning which will follow 11:30am Mass and will take place in the church due to the Grotto renovation. I hope you will join us.

The Grotto project renovations are now well underway, and I would like to share a quick update:

The entire project, including a maintenance reserve, is estimated to cost \$280,000; and, to date, \$96,000 has been spent on masonry materials and foundations. Fortunately, \$164,000 was already set aside, leaving approximately \$116,000 needed to complete the project.

I hope you will consider supporting this legacy project for current parishioners and future generations. For your convenience, a monthly envelope for this project is now available in your parish envelope packets. Donations can be made by check payable to St. Peter the Apostle, or electronically with GiveCentral or Zelle using the QR code found on page 6. Donors will be recognized for their generosity on the Donor Tree columns at the entrance to the Grotto. Feel free to reach out to me or Jenny Anderson with questions.

WHAT IS AURACAST?

Auracast is a new Bluetooth® audio technology that allows sound to be broadcast directly to compatible hearing aids, cochlear implants, headphones, or smartphones. Instead of relying solely on speakers in the church, Auracast sends clear, high-quality audio straight to personal devices.

How does this increase accessibility?

For individuals with hearing loss, Auracast can significantly improve speech clarity by reducing background noise and echoes. It allows listeners to hear the spoken word more clearly and comfortably, helping them stay connected to the liturgy without distraction or strain.

Parishioners who are interested in learning more about Auracast can visit the Auracast website at www.bluetooth.com/auracast for additional information.

Those who wear hearing aids or cochlear implants are also encouraged to speak with their audiologist to see if their devices are Auracast-compatible and how to enable this feature. Additionally, parishioner and audiologist, Dr. Marie Toalson, will speak at an information session on **Monday May 11, at 6:30pm** to provide further details and answer questions.

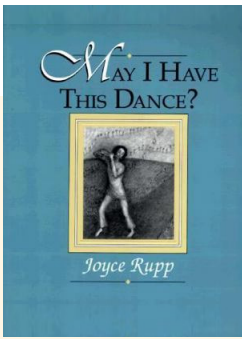

BLESSED VIRGIN MARY GROTTA RENOVATION PROJECT

The Blessed Virgin Mary Grotto on the north side of the school building holds a special place for our parish community – celebrating May Crowning, capturing photos of special occasions such as First Communion or Confirmation, praying weekly Tuesday Evening Rosary outdoors in warm months, and of course it is a place of respite for personal prayer.

The statue was acquired from Italy and was originally donated by Mr./Mrs. Robert and Gerry Barth, and Mr./Mrs. Phil Starbuck, in memory of their children, Brian Barth (age 5), and Mary Gwen Starbuck (age 6), both of whom died tragically at an early age.

Throughout the years, parishioners have made time to meditate in the grotto, praying for Mary's guidance and intercession. Unfortunately, over time, the statue has undergone damage, leaving Mary's thumbs broken, and the grotto itself needs refreshing.

After prayerful consideration, and months of planning, renovations are now underway.

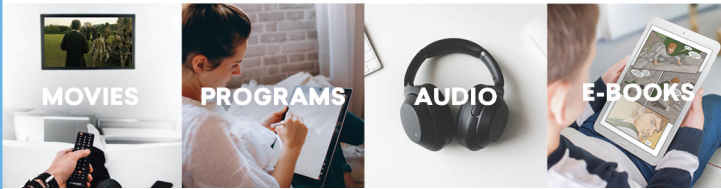

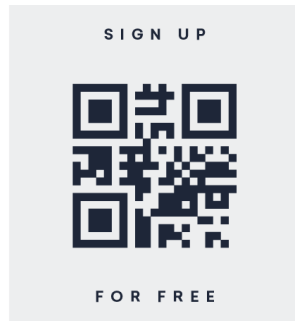

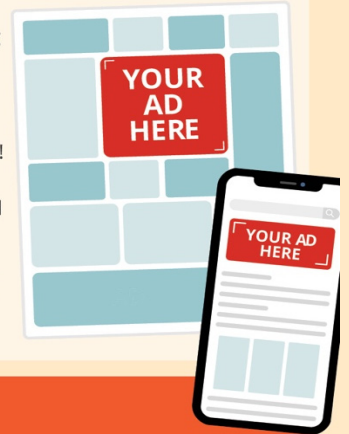
