## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners:

God is good! On June 7, 1986, the late Bishop Joseph L Imesch ordained me and four other men to the priesthood of Jesus Christ at St. Raymond Nonnatus in Joliet. It was one of the most beautiful days of my life. And, that was 40 years ago today. My first assignment as Parochial Vicar was at St. Mary of Gostyn, in Downers Grove (1986-92). After that I was assigned as Parochial Vicar at St. Francis Assisi in Bolingbrook (1992-96). I then went to St. Alexander in Villa Park as Parochial Vicar (1996-2000), and later became Pastor (2000-2012). From there I went to serve as Pastor at St. Mary in Minooka (2012-2023). Finally, since 2023, I have been Pastor here at St. Peter the Apostle in Itasca.

For 40 years of my life as a priest, I have been blessed and graced by God to be surrounded by people who speak the language that God speaks — the language of love. Indeed, God speaks the language of love. As St. John says, “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.” This is God’s language of love.

When people speak the language of love, I am touched and transformed. It then helps me to speak the language of love as well. When you speak love, you have power to transform people’s lives. Saint Teresa of Calcutta emphasized that “Not all of us can do great things, but we can do small things with great love.”

It has been a wonderful 40 years as a priest. I want to thank my family, the people who God sent into my life, because the simple things they do for me, they do with great love, and it has shaped me to be who I am today as a priest. They have blessed me with their love and prayers.

Finally, many thanks to everyone involved in organizing my 40th Anniversary Celebration — Denise Panettone, Diane Blackburn, and Patti Zubak for overseeing the planning, as well as all of the parish staff for their support, and the Knights of Columbus for assisting during the event. Eucharist is Thanksgiving; and, on this Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, I am abundantly thankful to celebrate the Eucharist with everyone on this special day.

Remember God loves you, and I love you and pray for you!
