There's still time to pray the Surrender Novena and help raise funds for the **Blessed Virgin Mary Grotto Renovation Project**.



If you haven't already, please join our parish community on the Hallow app and watch for this next Parish Challenge to begin as we pray the *Surrender Novena*.

The Blessed Virgin Mary Grotto renovation is now complete and is a welcoming respite for the entire community to visit and pray.

The statue, acquired from Italy, was originally donated by Mr./Mrs. Robert and Gerry Barth, and Mr./Mrs. Phil Starbuck, in memory of their children, Brian Barth (age 5), and Mary Gwen Starbuck (age 6), both of whom died tragically at an early age.

Over time, the statue became weathered and in need of repair, prompting the grotto renovation project. The statue has now been restored and returned to a new home befitting her.

Although the project is complete, there is a remaining balance to cover the costs of the renovation.

To help raise the additional funds, the parish has partnered with **Hallow** to offer a **Giving Campaign**. As an added benefit, **Hallow will match funds donated through the app up to \$5,000**.

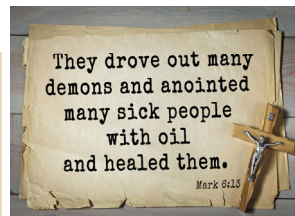

Anointing of the Sick is an opportunity to bring chronic ills of body, mind, and spirit to the Lord in a special way.

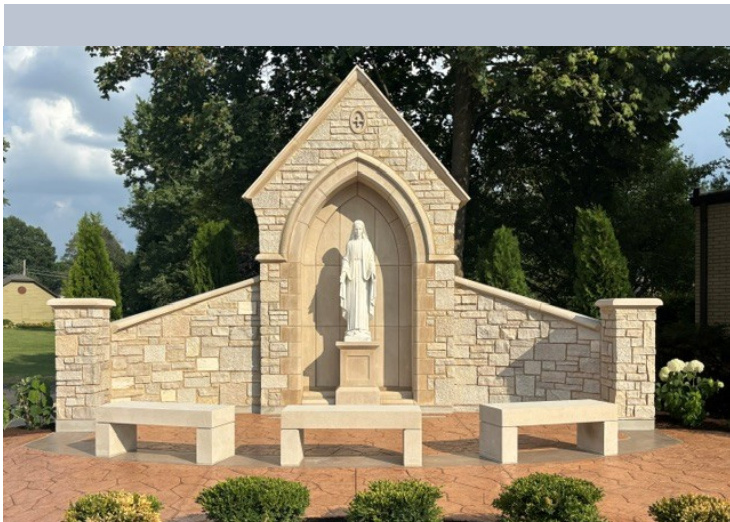
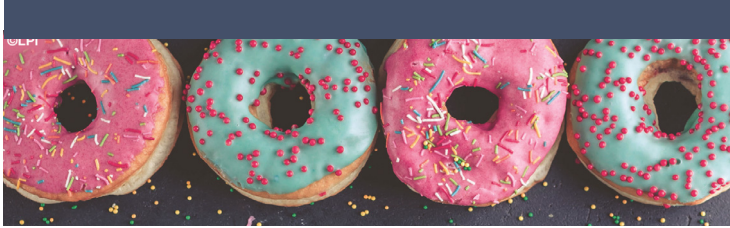
The Sacrament is often an experience of God's healing love.

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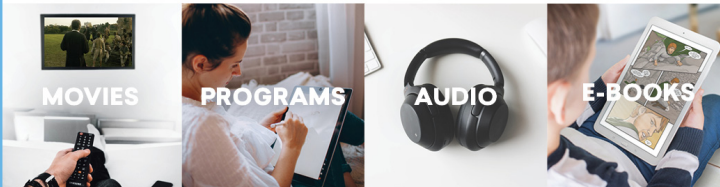
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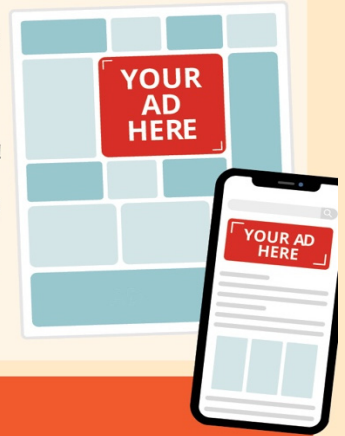
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
